Rules Emphasis

HCOP – Head Contact

NYHL – Body Checking, CFB, Charging, Goaltender
Interference and Boarding

KEEP IT SAFE and FAIR

Pre-Game

Be ON the ice BEFORE the players : NY rule 24.15

- ◆ No player may be on the ice before the Zamboni doors are closed. A BENCH MINOR penalty shall be assessed

START of GAME

- ◆ 3 Minutes after nets pegged
- ◆ First 2 minutes— fair play, rink check, game sheet, etc
- ◆ 45 seconds left – Official goes to center dot and – **BLOWS WHISTLE!!!**
- ◆ At the buzzer – face off or delay of game to least ready team
- ◆ No pucks on ice until nets pegged

Timeouts

- ◆ There are NO timeouts in any regular season play
- ◆ Timeouts will be permitted in Semi finals and Finals only. One per team.

Injured Players

- ◆ For NYHL games, if the trainer comes on to the ice, then the player has to sit out one stoppage before he can return.



- Primary hub for coaching resources related to NYHL
- Contains important forms, documents and resources
- All submissions will be available for online submission straight from our website
- Tournament/Exhibition game sheet submission, tiering forms, all star ballots etc.

TIERING

FALL TIERING

- Teams will be tiered for the Fall Season
 - Based on Tiering forms submitted on September 18th
- Fall Tiering released with the first week of the schedule

WINTER TIERING

- Winter Season Tiering Forms to be submitted by Nov 22nd
- Tiering committee will meet November 25th for their first draft
- Clubs will respond to tiering proposal by November 27th.
- Final tiers will be published with the schedule on or before December 2nd.
- In season adjustments may be made in exceptional circumstances

AP PLAYERS

- A “chain affiliate” is a club team of the same name.
- U7 to U10
 - A player may be brought up from a chain affiliate in a **lower tier**
 - From the house league of the same division
- U11 to U13
 - From a chain affiliate in a **lower tier**
 - From a chain affiliate from **ONE YEAR below**
 - From the house league of the same division
- U14 to U21
 - From a chain affiliate in a **lower tier**
 - From a chain affiliate up to **TWO YEARS below**
 - From the house league of the same division

MIN / MAX BENCH STRENGTH

- **Minimum Bench Strength**

- U7 to U9

- Minimum Bench is 13 players

- If a team has 12 or less players available, an AP player can be called up

- U10 to U21

- Minimum Bench is 15 players

- If a team has 14 or less players available, an AP player can be called up

- **Goalies are included in the minimum bench count**

- Exceptions can be made if the team is at minimum bench strength but does not have a goalie

- **Maximum Bench Strength**

- U7-U9 – 16 skaters + 2 goalies

- U10-U21 - 18 skaters + 2 goalies

- For a game to start, a team must ice a minimum of 6 skaters or 5 skaters and 1 goalie.

AP PLAYER RESTRICTIONS

- **AP Player Restrictions BEFORE Jan 15th**
 - **An AP player can be called up regardless of minimum bench strength before Jan 15th**
 - **AP players cannot be added if the team will exceed the maximum bench strength**
- **AP Player Restrictions STARTING Jan 15th**
 - **Chain Affiliate** = 5 games – only 2 of which can be in the playoffs
 - **House League** = 5 games PLUS 2 in the playoffs
 - A team may **ONLY** call up an AP if they are below their minimum bench strength and may only call up enough to reach the appropriate **minimum bench strength**
- Teams may use a maximum of five (5) AP's in any one game
- AP players **MUST** be added to the EGS as an Affiliated Player (see [EGS Manual](#) on our [Coaches Portal](#))

BAD WEATHER POLICY

- Cancelled games will be posted on the NYHL website and our social media accounts via Facebook, Instagram and Twitter by 3 pm.
- Club contacts will be notified via email as well
- Local Toronto radio stations will also be notified of any cancellations.
- Please refrain from calling the office.

CHALLENGE OF CHAMPIONS

- Saturday April 26 and Sunday April 27
- Championship Team vs. All Star Team of the champions tier
- Champions receive their championship trophies and All Stars receive commemorative All-Star t-shirts
- Championship team **MUST** be available to play.



ALL STAR NOMINATIONS

- Ballot on Coach's Portal
- 5 players nominated by the team
 - Players are picked in order of nomination
- Each team will nominate 3 goalies within their tier who are not on their team
- Please DO NOT tell the kids they have been nominated as all listed players may not be selected

NYHL SCHEDULING

- Fall Season starts Oct 7th.
- No Games Oct 12th, 13th and 14th (Thanksgiving Weekend)
- Winter Season will start around Dec 16th.
- 3 week rolling schedule
- 24 hour notice minimum for games in the playoffs
- No games between Dec 24 to Jan 1
- No games March Break – March 10th to 17th
- No games Easter weekend – April 18 – April 21

START OF GAME PROCEDURE

- Prior to entering dressing room, notify Rink Attendant of any issues with dressing room
- A game may start up to 15 minutes before the scheduled start time if BOTH teams and officials are ready and BOTH teams agree
- 3 minutes on clock
- 0:45 left whistle
- Team least ready at end of 3 warm up – minor penalty Delay of Game

GAME TIMES

- U7 – U9 18 X 18 (stop time)
 - Last 10 minutes of period 2 will be run time during a 5 goal spread
 - U9 before Jan 10
- U9 – U14 12 – 12 – 12
 - U9 starting Jan 10
- U15 - U21 12-12-15
- Flood will be after every game except for U7 – U9 due to boards
- Game times will remain the same for playoffs
- 5 goal spread rule – running time in the 3rd period until deficit is dropped to 3.
- Timeouts – One per team will be allowed in the Semi Final and Final ONLY

END OF GAME PROCEDURE

- Referee to direct coach to hold bench.
- One team exits at a time.
- Dressing room door must be open (GM99 to the coach)
- Game sheet will be uploaded by the end of the night and available by the next morning

NO SHOW POLICY

- 10 minutes on clock
- After 10 minutes, 40 minute run time for team that is present to practice.
- Absent team forfeits and is fined

DEFAULT IN PLAYOFFS

- Incurs a serious fine and expulsion from playoffs.
- We emphasize exhausting every AP option
- If you are unable to ice a sufficient number of players, we ask that you withdraw the team rather than to disrupt the schedule.

TOURNAMENTS AND EXEMPTION DAYS

- 3 In-Season tournaments plus Preseason, Thanksgiving, Winter Break, March Break, Easter Weekend and Post Season
- Tournaments remove you from the schedule for 3 days (Fri-Sun)
- Allowed 2 additional exemption days (club events, extra travel days)
- Teams are also allowed 2 Religious Exemption days in the final week of the season and playoffs – on interfaith calendar.
- Applications for above must be submitted 5 weeks in advance
- Submit requests through Agilex
- Game sheets must be submitted 48 hours upon completion of the event through the Coaches Portal
- Game sheets must be legible

SUSPENSIONS

- Team staff will receive an email notifying of the suspended player
- Any player with a GM, Gross Misconduct or Match Penalty must sit out until the NYHL office advises the club contact of the suspension.
 - We don't want kids sitting due to bureaucracy and will respond within 24-48 hours
- Queries and complaints to the league must go through your Club Contact.

PROTESTS AND APPEALS

- Protests must be in the NYHL office within 48 hours of a suspension decision or a game and incurs a \$250 fee
 - The fee is returned if the protest is won
- There are no appeals for suspensions fewer than 6 games

INJURED PLAYERS

- If play is stopped due to an injured player the injured player must sit out 1 stoppage of play.
- If player leaves the game and does not return due to injury, a HC report must be submitted within 48 hours. This can be found on our Coaches Portal.
- If visiting a practitioner due to injury, must have a note to return to play

Game Times 2 X 18 Stop – 5 goal spread last 10 minutes run time

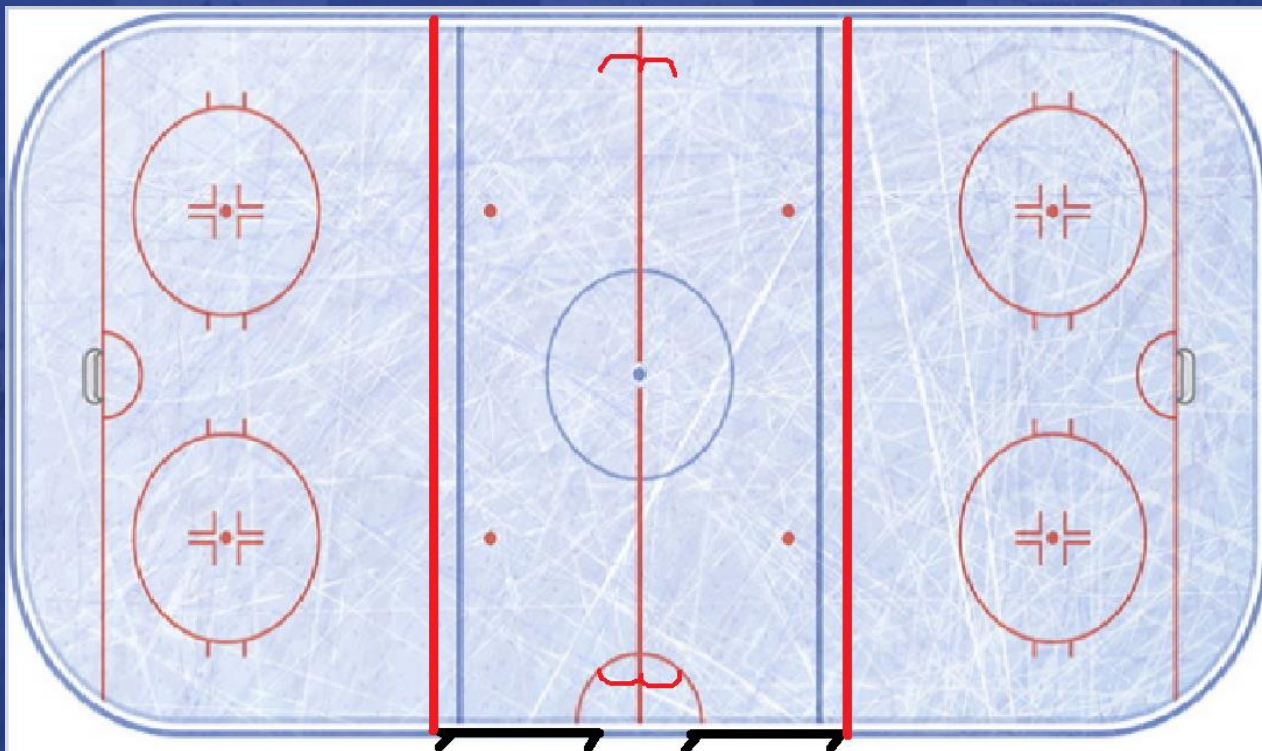
Home team will start at opposite end to allow equal bench advantage

Face-offs will occur as per usual game to allow for line changes etc.

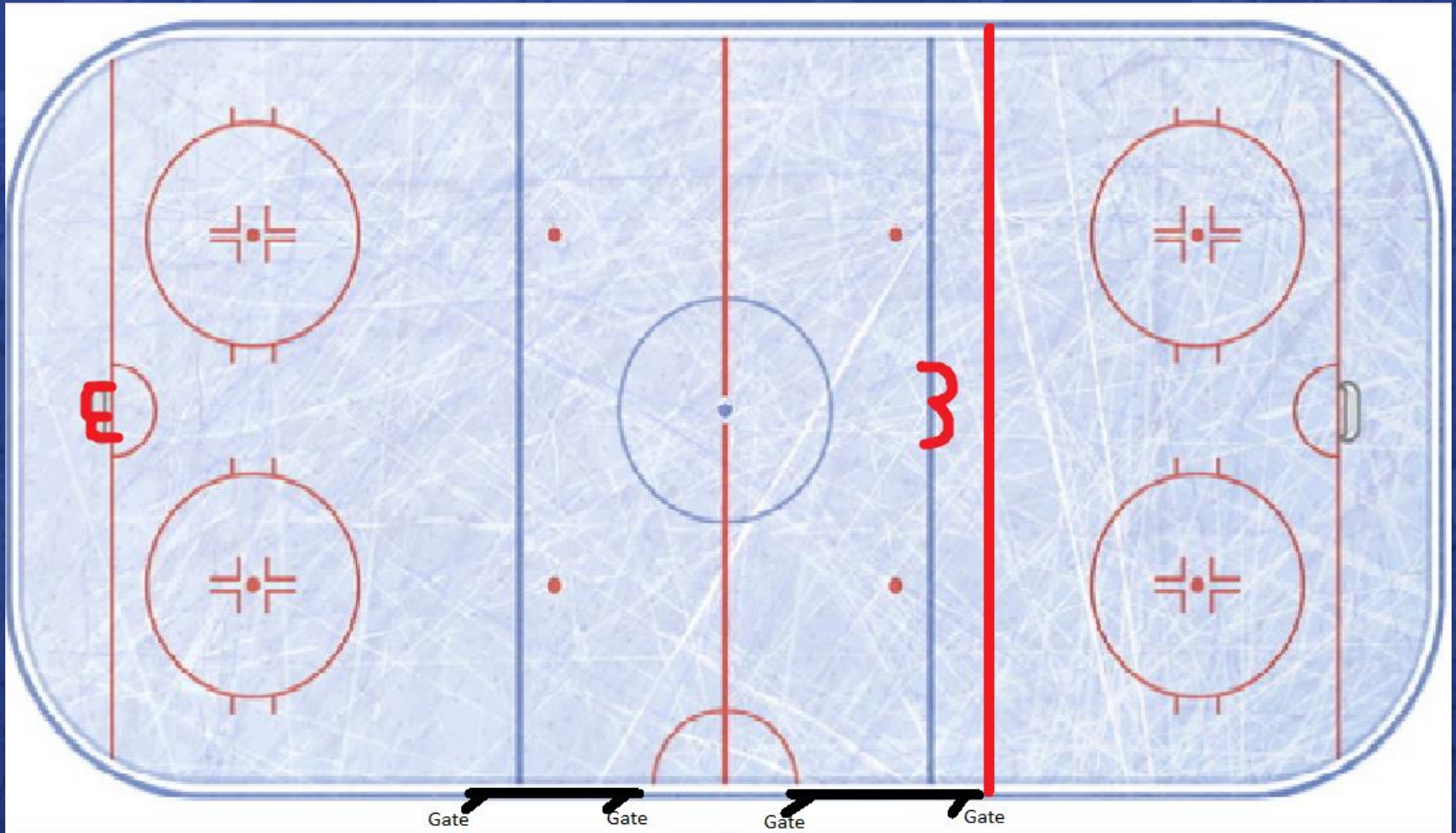
BOARD SET UP

- Teams are responsible for setting up the boards.
- A coach from each team **MUST** aid timekeepers and officials with setting up **AND** taking down boards
- Boards may have to be moved for possible floods.
- Boards must be set up before the first game and taken down after last game.
- Boards **MUST** be taken off the ice and stored correctly
- Safety equipment is available at all arenas with Boards
- Teams may be fined for non compliance
